

## EXERCISE 40-1 Chord spelling

### Set 2

- D minor: uppercase six
- F major: lowercase one
- A major: two half-diminished 7
- E-flat major: uppercase flat-three
- D major: uppercase six
- F-sharp minor: uppercase three

### Set 3

- B-flat major: lowercase six
- C-sharp major: lowercase two 7
- G minor: two half-diminished 7
- D major: uppercase natural-three
- E minor: uppercase seven
- F minor: uppercase six
