
EXERCISE 8-5 Whole-tone scales in context


This scale uses only whole steps all the time.



E whole tone. After writing the E whole tone scale below or on a separate sheet of staff paper, study and listen to its use in Worksheet example 8-18.




Worksheet example 8-18. Claude Debussy, Voiles, mm. 1-4
