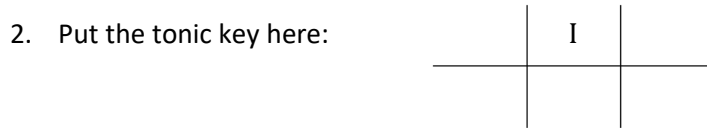
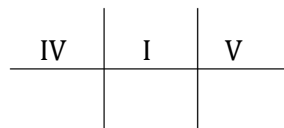


# Figure 33-1. Finding closely related keys from a major base key, using a visual model

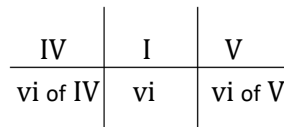
If the original key is major:



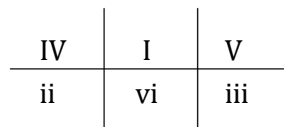
3. Find IV and V and put them in their respective places to the left and right of tonic:
