

Figure 33-1. Finding closely related keys from a major base key, using a visual model

If the original key is major:



3. Find IV and V and put them in their respective places to the left and right of tonic:



4. Find all of the relative minor keys and place them beneath each major key:

IV	Ι	V
vi of IV	vi	vi of V

Another way to think of step 4 is:

IV	Ι	V
ii	vi	iii
