
Figure 33-2. Finding closely related keys from a minor base key, using a visual model

3. Find iv and v and put them in their respective places to the left and right of tonic:



4. Find all of the relative major keys and place them above each minor key:

Another way to think of step 4 is:

VI	III	VII
iv	i	V
