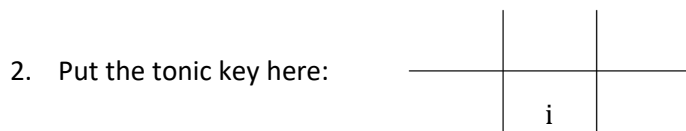
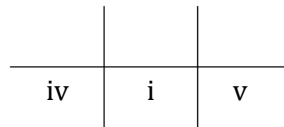


Figure 33-2. Finding closely related keys from a minor base key, using a visual model

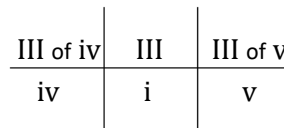
If the original key is minor:



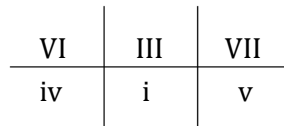
3. Find iv and v and put them in their respective places to the left and right of tonic:
